- Directions to The Wadsworth Atheneum:
 - Front Street South Garage— the Wadsworth Atheneum’s “Official Parking Lot” just steps from the museum!
 - GPS Address: Front Street Crossing, Hartford, CT (Once you turn onto Front Street Crossing, the garage entrance is on your right)
 - \$3 flat daily rate for museum visitors with validation in the Museum Shop daily until 11:59pm 7 days a week. Not valid for overnight parking.

 - Front Street North Garage
 - GPS Address: Front Street Crossing, Hartford, CT (Once you turn onto Front Street Crossing, the garage entrance is straight ahead)
 - \$3 flat daily rate for museum visitors with validation in the Museum Shop until 8 pm weekdays. Must exit via the cashier lane. No weekend validation. Not valid for overnight parking.

 - Trumbull on the Park Garage
 - GPS Address: 100 Trumbull St Hartford, CT 06103
 - \$3 flat daily rate for museum visitors with validation in the Museum Shop until 6 pm weekdays. No weekend validation. Not valid for overnight parking.
 - On Street Parking
 - Kiosk parking is available for \$1 per hour. The kiosks accept coins, debit cards, and credit cards. Display the printed parking receipt on the dashboard inside your vehicle. Please observe posted signs. Some areas are tow zones after 3:30 pm on weekdays. On street parking is always FREE after 6 pm on weekdays and all day on weekends.
 - Handicap Parking
 - It is suggested that visitors with disabilities park on the Main Street side of the museum to access the ramp at the Main Street entrance. Please approach the Main Street entrance from the south at Burr Mall to bypass access the ramp.
- Arrive to the museum no earlier than 30 minutes prior to our performance (because of space limitations) for check in and preparation. However, please also allow time for parking.
- Enter at the side entrance – Avery Court, Atheneum Square North, between Main Street and Prospect Street. Avery Court entrance telephone is (860) 838-4050.
- Please note: ONLY performers, music directors, and school chaperones are guests of Festival and receive complimentary admission that day. Family and friends MUST pay admission to view the performances and exhibits. This is a major museum fundraising event and complimentary admissions are not valid at this time. Please inform others coming of this policy.
- After entering via the Avery Building’s doors, proceed directly into the Hartford Courant Room upon arrival. Families of performers will not be allowed in the Hartford Courant Room before and after performances due to space limitations and security.
- Performers will warm up in Loctite Lobby and proceed to their designated performance area for their performances.
- Family and friends should allow extra time to park, purchase their tickets at the main entrance on Main Street, and be seated in Avery Court. Please visit the [museum’s website](#) for parking
